

RESOLUTION NO. 57-87

PATHS AND TRAILS RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, due to the requirements of RCW 47.30.030, it is required of the county to set aside no less than an amount equal to one-half of 1% of the gas tax collected in each year that is in excess of \$600,000 for a Paths and Trails Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS, Mason County Road Fund has received gas tax funds in excess of this amount since 1979. The total amount from 1979 through 1986 is \$6,839,361.00. One-half of 1% of this amount is \$34,196.00


WHEREAS, since Mason County does not have the required adopted Comprehensive Plan for the expenditures of these funds, it is necessary to set them aside in a reserve fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Treasurer is hereby directed to establish a Paths and Trails Reserve Fund. Funds shall be transferred from the Road Fund to the Paths and Trails Reserve Fund in the amount of \$34,196.00 for 1979 through 1986 plus the amount to be yet determined for 1987.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Paths and Trails Reserve Fund shall accumulate the aforementioned funds until such time as a plan has been established to expend them.
