WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 3 on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

Perform Preliminary Engineering only for installation of cantelevered flashing signal lights with drop gate protector.

and that said work is to be performed by day labor in accordance with (day labor/contract) the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.
