RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO GRANT FRANCHISE AND NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, Mason County Board of Commissioners intends to grant a franchise for the purpose of providing cable television service to specific areas of Mason County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have received an application to provide cable television service by Hood Canal Cablevision, P. O. Box 249, Union, WA 98592-0249; and

WHEREAS, Hood Canal Cablevision has proposed to provide cable television service to the following areas of Mason County served by County roads in area of Lilliwaup Falls west to Cushman Lake and south to include the Skokomish Valley:

Township 23 North, Range 3 West Sections 19-20, 24, 31

Township 23 North, Range 4 West Sections 19-36

Township 22 North, Range 4 West Sections 1-23, 26-35

Township 21 North, Range 4 West Sections 2-11, 14-23

Township 21 North, Range 4 West Sections 1-3, 10-12, 13-15, 22-24

WHEREAS, the franchise for cable television service sets forth provisions for a minimum number of viewing channels, plus additional terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution Granting a Franchise is available in the Office of the County Commissioners for review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that a call for Public Hearing is issued and is scheduled for July 12, 1988, at the hour of 9:30 a.m. for the purpose of the citizens of Mason County to appear before the Board to express their interest in, or objections to, the granting of a franchise to Hood Canal Cablevision. The Public Hearing will be held in the Commissioners' Chambers in the Mason County Courthouse Annex II.
