RESOLUTION NO. 61-88

A RESOLUTION AMENDING MASON COUNTY CODES CHAPTER 9.04.220 RESTRICTED LAKES

WHEREAS, Mason County Codes Chapter 9.04.220, Restricted Lakes adopted on August 1, 1960 prohibits the use of motor boats on named lakes of twenty (20) acres or less,

WHEREAS, public hearings were held on Tuesday July 12, 1988 and Tuesday August 2, 1988 to consider amending the ordinance to allow the use of battery powered motor boats.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that effective immediately, Mason County Codes Chapter 9.04.220, Restricted Lakes shall be amended as follows:

9.04.220 Restricted Lakes. Because of their relatively small area, tendency to contain snags or submerged water hazards, or other safety hazards existing therein, the lakes or bodies of water set out below shall be subject to the following restrictions:

Internal combustion (ie: gasoline and/or diesel) powered motor boats shall not be permitted at any time on any of the following named lakes of less than twenty (20) acres in area:

The Sheriff shall annually prepare and post at convenient public places adjacent to the lakes listed above, public notices which shall specify the specific restrictions applicable to the particular lake as set out in this chapter. Notices shall be posted on the wharf or dock of each boat livery and adjacent to public launching ramps, docks or wharves and at such locations as will reasonably inform the boating public of these restrictions.
