SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING


WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for 1988, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to a grant from the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission for a DWI/Traffic Safety Program in Mason County.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 8th day of November, 1988, at the hour of 9:15 a.m., the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, at the Courthouse Annex II, Shelton, Washington, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Probation Services fund, in the estimated amount of \$2,778.00, for the above-mentioned purposes, and the Clerk of the Board be and hereby is authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
