

RESOLUTION NO. 15-90

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1990, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the Current Expense budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to agreements for partial program funding from Mason, Kitsap and Jefferson Counties, Puget Sound Water Quality Authority, University of Washington Sea-Grant and Washington State University Cooperative Extension to fund a three (3) county area Aquaculture-Water Quality Field Agent.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:


That the 27th day of February, at the hour of 10:30 a.m., the Board of Mason County Commissioners at Courthouse Building I, Shelton, Washington, will hold a public hearing upon the matter of a supplemental appropriation to establish a new budget for AQUACULTURE-WATER QUALITY EDUCATION under the direction of the Cooperative Extension office, in the amount of FORTY-SEVEN THOUSAND (\$47,000) DOLLARS (\$37,000 unanticipated revenue and \$10,000 transfer from within the 1990 Current Expense Budget), for the purpose of education and Aquaculture-Water Quality issues in the three-County area of Mason, Kitsap and Jefferson counties.


This public hearing will also be held on the matter of a line item transfer of \$10,000 within Current Expense from the budget of Cooperative Extension into the Aquaculture-Water Quality Education budget.

The Clerk of the Board is authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
