- 1) A three percent (3%) increase in salary for all non-union employees for the calendar year 1993, effective January 1, 1993.
- 2) The non-union salary range alignment schedule, affixed hereto as Attachment A is approved and adopted.
 - 3) The 1993 salary plan affixed hereto as Attachment B is approved and adopted.
- 4) The Board recognizes that all non-union employees paid lesser amounts than Step A in the 1992 salary plan, affixed hereto as Attachment C deserve payments in the amounts listed in the 1993 salary plan Step A for the calendar year 1993. The Board approves and adopts those salaries listed in the 1993 salary plan Step A for the calendar year 1993.
- 5) The non-union salary schedule for non-union positions during the calendar year 1993, affixed hereto as Attachment D, is hereby approved and adopted.
