SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reasons of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1997, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to a grant for Juvenile Truancy/the Becca Bill and grants to Emergency Services for the Winter Storm supplies.
