1997 BUDGET

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reasons of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1997, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the Current Expense Fund for 1997 Teamsters (General Services Unit) and 1996/1997 Woodworkers Local Lodge W 38 I.A.M. Wage and Benefit Settlements.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the 21st day of October 1997 at the hour of 9:10 am, in the County Commission Chambers, Courthouse, Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, be and the same hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the emergency appropriation (s) to the budget for **Current Expense**, in the estimated amount of \$262,766 for the above-mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
