

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reasons of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1997, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to the following:

Landfill Fund: Sale of timber to be used for future construction needs;

Skokomish Flood Hazard Mitigation Fund: grant revenue from the Washington State Military Department and an operating transfer from the Parks Department for land aquisition;

Emergency Services/Current Expense Fund: Federal and State grants for the replacement of storm damaged equipment.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the 21st day of October, 1997 at the hour of 9:45 am, in the County Commission Chambers, Courthouse, Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, be and the same hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation (s) to the budget as follows:
