1997 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1997, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to a contribution from Simpson Timber Company for the purchase of emergency equipment and supplies.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:




The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.


