1997 BUDGET

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reasons of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1997, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the Current Expense Fund for Union medical/dental benefits, settlements in the Auditor's Office, the cost of detention for Juveniles, sick leave and annual leave payouts and insurance premiums.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the 30th day of December, 1997 at the hour of 9:20 am, in the County Commission Chambers, Courthouse, Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, be and the same hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the emergency appropriation (s) to the budget for Current Expense, in the estimated amount of \$101,760 for the above-mentioned purposes.
