1997 BUDGET

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1997, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100 to meet an outstanding obligation of : *the General Services Administration Department, the Parks Department, GHCF Staff Support Department and the Ending Fund Balance in the Current Expense Fund for the establishment of a one stop permitting process and the Permit Assistance Center.*

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:




