


RESOLUTION NO. 79-97
RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH COUNTY ROAD

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, August 5, 1997, in conformance with RCW 36.81.010, the Board of County Commissioners entered upon their Minutes a motion declaring their intent to establish as a County Maintained Road, HOMESTEAD DRIVE, County Road No. 67150; a newly constructed road with a paved surface being 0.22 mile long, beginning at the intersection with Old Ranch Road, running easterly to intersection with State Route 3. Said road is located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 22 North, Range 1 West, W.M

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed county road is a public necessity, and that the County Engineer be directed to report thereon, and the Clerk of the Board shall fix a time and place for hearing the report as required by statute, and that the Prosecuting Attorney be requested to review and give approval to the steps herein ordered.




