1997 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reasons of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1997, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to a grant from the State Department of Ecology for Skokomish River Flood Warning System Improvements, PUD reimbursements for supplies and private contributions to help repair storm damage.


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners:


The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.




