

ORDINANCE NO. 102-98

NOISE CONTROL

An Ordinance to amend Section 9.36.120, (Ordinance #54-89) Public disturbance noises

WHEREAS, a citizens committee was formed to improve the Dangerous Dog Ordinance No. 39-90;

WHEREAS, the Mason County Animal Ordinance No. 84-98 was adopted on July 28, 1998 and the intent was to not exclude frequent, repetitive or continuous sounds from any animals made in commercial or pet kennels;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mason County Board of Commissioners to amend Section 9.36.120, Noise Control, of the Mason County Code, as follows:

- (1) Frequent, repetitive, or continuous sounds made by any animal which unreasonably disturbs or interferes with the peace, comfort, and repose of property owners or possessors, except that such sounds made by pigs, cattle, sheep, horses, goats, and poultry, whether from commercial or noncommercial activities; and such sounds made in animal shelters, ~~commercial kennels~~, veterinary hospitals, pet shops, grooming parlors or ~~pet kennels~~ shall be exempt under this subsection;




