## SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1998, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to unbudgeted beginning fund balance; WA State CJAA grant for staff training; MCRA batting cage program revenue; and a grant from the City of Bremerton for expansion of the emergency notification system to include residents downstream of Casad Dam.
