1998 BUDGET

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1998, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet outstanding obligations of the Current Expense Fund for professional services, jury fees, and criminal witness fees in Superior Court; cost of the 1997 State Audit; and retirement benefits for the Fire Marshal.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:


