

**RESOLUTION NO. 133-98**  
**TO IMPLEMENT A 1.7% INCREASE**  
**FOR NON-UNION EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, RCW 36.40.080 states that "...the Board of county commissioners shall fix and determine each item of the budget separately and shall by resolution adopt the budget...";

WHEREAS, RCW 36.16.070 states that "...the Board shall fix the compensation of all employees...";

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the compensation of Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys should be increased:


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby amend the non-union salary plan (Attachment A) by increasing salaries 1.7% effective January 1, 1998. Such increase shall not be applicable to employees in the class of Juvenile Detention Officer since they are now represented by a Union.
