WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 70390, known locally as the North Shore (Burma) Road, and more specifically located in <u>Section 33</u>, <u>Township 23 North, Range 3 West, W.M.</u>, M.P. <u>21.70</u> to M.P. <u>21.80</u>, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as #4 (County-wide minor construction) on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

Acquire needed right-of-way agreements, install an interceptor drain, and repair the road to original condition with required safety features.

SAID WORK is to be performed by <u>day labor</u> in accordance with the Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:
