SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1998, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100 and RCW 36.40.195, due to Federal and State grants for operating expenses and emergency Skokomish Flood mitigation in Emergency Services; additional charges for traffic enforcement in the Sheriff's Department; "Fun Days" program contributions in the Convention/Fairgrounds; Federal and State grants for the Lilliwaup Bay Onsite Sewage Correction System in Environmental Health/Water Quality; Lower Hood Canal CWD funding for the Lower Hood Canal Survey Project in Environmental Health/Water Quality; and a loan from the State Dept. of Ecology for engineering costs in Wastewater/North Bay Case Inlet Fund.
