

**RESOLUTION NO. 65-98**  
**TO IMPLEMENT A 2% SALARY INCREASE**  
**FOR NON-UNION EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, RCW 36.40.080 states that "...the Board of County Commissioners shall fix and determine each item of the budget separately and shall by resolution adopt the budget...";

WHEREAS, RCW 36.16.070 states that "...the Board shall fix the compensation of all employees...";

WHEREAS the Board has determined that salaries of non-union employees should be increased:


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby amend the non-union salary plan (Attachment A) by increasing salaries 2% effective March 11, 1998. Such increase shall not be applicable to employees in the job classes of Public Health Nurse/Coordinator, Program Coordinator, and Clinic Nurse which are now represented by a union.
