2001 BUDGET  
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2001, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to fire warden needs in the Fire Marshal program and professional services needs in Civil Service. These needs will be funded by unbudgeted beginning fund balance.**
