

RESOLUTION NO. 77-01
2001 BUDGET
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2001, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to:**

Unbudgeted beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund which will be used for excess compensation for retirement benefits for former treasurer; establishing a .4 FTE Office Assistant position in Emergency Management Department and increasing cost of extra help; increasing administrative assistant's work hours in the Coroner's Office; increase in salaries for district court judges and superior court judges.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the **21st day of August, 2001** at the hour of **9:45 a.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of a supplemental appropriation to the budget for the: Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of **\$23,482.**

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.






