2001 BUDGET
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2001, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to:**

Treasurer's foreclosure fees to be used for unexpected costs of property tax foreclosures. Unbudgeted beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund which will be used for the increase in employer contributions for employee medical/dental benefits, leave payout for a retiring Sheriff's Department deputy, and the cost of adding four jailers to jail staff. A grant from the WA Counties Risk Pool which will be used for the skid car for training in the Sheriff's Office.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the 18th day of **September, 2001** at the hour of **10:15 a.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of a supplemental appropriation to the budget for the:
