

**RESOLUTION NO. 133-02**  
**2002 BUDGET**  
**SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING**

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2002, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: **Maggie Lake Water District Assessments on county property, positions reclassified in the Treasurer's Office, an increase in the Sheriff's salary, L& I mandated medical evaluations of the Sheriff's HAZMAT team members, and the estimated cost of the 101 Connector/Bypass audit.**

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the **15th of October, 2002** at the hour of **9:15 am** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of a supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$34,587.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
