

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PROPOSAL BY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT 5 MASON COUNTY FOR AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, Fire Protection District 5 Mason County has placed a proposition on the ballot at the November 5, 2002 General Election; and

WHEREAS, said proposition will be for authorization for the District to collect an Emergency Medical Service Levy of 50 cents per thousand dollars of assessed value; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services are regarded by this Board of Commissioners as an essential public service; and

WHEREAS, this Commission recognizes the outstanding efforts by District 5 and the other Fire Departments of the County to provide EMS services to the citizens of Mason County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mason County Board of Commissioners declares its support of this Emergency Medical Services Levy request by District 5.




