A ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 41-99 AND ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE MASON COUNTY PLANNING DIVISION'S PERMITS, ACTIONS, AND SERVICES

WHEREAS, collection of fees for processing various land use permits, action, and services is necessary due to the fact that County revenue is insufficient to cover the costs of administrative services provided by the Department of Community Development;

WHEREAS, the fees established herein are for the purpose of providing such services and supplementing the existing revenues and budget;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on November 19, 2002 for the purpose of taking public testimony and to deliberate on the action to be taken;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the following actions:

<u>Section 1</u>: Section 1.10.020 of the Mason County Department Of Community Development Fee Ordinance as adopted in Ordinance #41-99 is amended as attached.

<u>Section 2</u>: Section 1.10.050 of the Mason County Department Of Community Development Fee Ordinance as adopted in Ordinance #41-99 is amended to read: "Prior fees and provisions set forth in this ordinance supersede any prior fees and provisions set forth by ordinance or resolution for the administrative services covered herein."

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effective on January 1, 2003.

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MASON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FINDINGS OF FACT November 19, 2002

1. As currently authorized by Ordinance 41-99, the collection of fees for processing various land use permits, action, and services is insufficient to cover the costs of administrative services provided by the Department of Community Development.
2. The proposed fees are by best estimate adequate to cover the administrative permitting and permit related service costs of the Planning Division, although they do not cover the full county cost of providing these services.
3. The revised fees allows the county to continue to provide other mandated or vital public services.
4. Some adjustments to the fees have been made to reduce the costs for smaller projects and single family development by providing for a sliding scale of fees for such projects.
5. The Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on November 19, 2002 for the purpose of taking public testimony and to deliberate on the action to be taken.
These findings provide a basis for approval of the proposed fee changes.

All fees are due on application for a complete application or on request for the service, except that hourly fees shall be due within 30 days of billing or prior to issuance of a permit, whichever is earlier.
