

RESOLUTION NO. 158-02
2002 BUDGET
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2002, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: **cost of medical expenses for LEOFF I retirees; increase in insurance premiums because of September 11th and a hard insurance market; and a salary increase for the Director of Facilities & Grounds for additional responsibilities assumed as a result of the retirement of the Director of Parks.**

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the **17th** day of **December, 2002** at the hour of **9:30 a.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of a supplemental appropriation to the budget for the: **Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$35,160.**

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.


