

RESOLUTION NO. 161-02
AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 145-01 TO IMPLEMENT A 2% SALARY INCREASE FOR CERTAIN DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS

WHEREAS, RCW 36.40.080 states that "...the Board of county Commissioners shall fix and determine each item of the budget separately and shall by resolution adopt the budget...";

WHEREAS, RCW 36.16.070 states that "...the Board shall fix the compensation of all employees...";

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the compensation of certain Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys should be adjusted;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby amend the Deputy Prosecutor's Salary Plan by increasing salaries by approximately 2% as specified in (Attachment A) effective January 1, 2003.


