RESOLUTION NO. 31-02

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MASON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTRASTATE CORRECTIONS COMPACT WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

WHEREAS, the legislature intends to enable and encourage a cooperative relationship between the state Department of Corrections and the counties of the state of Washington, providing adequate facilities and programs for the confinement, care, treatment, and employment of offenders through the exchange or transfer of offenders; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and beneficial for Mason County to carry out said intent by entering into an intrastate compact with the state Department of Corrections pursuant to Chapter 72.76 RCW;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Mason County shall enter into the Washington Intrastate Corrections Compact with the state Department of Corrections, <u>provided that</u> the language of said agreement shall be in the same substance and form as required by RCW 72.76.010.
