ORDINANCE NUMBER 75-02

AN ORDINANCE DISSOLVING THE EXISTING SHORELINE ADVISORY BOARD AND REMOVING ITS MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the Mason County Shoreline Advisory Board was established by Chapter 2.84 of the Mason County Code and are authorized pursuant to Chapter 90.58, RCW;

WHEREAS, the State Legislature changed state law to combined the Washington Growth Management Act and the Shoreline Management Act;

WHEREAS, the existence of two advisory boards both dealing with the same issues creates confusion, duplication of effort, and delays in the processing of permits and in the amendment of county regulations and plans;

WHEREAS, the Mason County Board of Commissioners desires to establish a single body to replace the two advisory groups to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the advisory process to the benefit of all parties; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to dissolve the two existing boards prior to combining them;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MASON COUNTY DO HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1:

The Shoreline Advisory Board Commission members are hereby removed from office.

Section 2:

The Shoreline Advisory Board created by Section 2.84.010 is hereby dissolved.
