

RESOLUTION NO 126-05
ALLOCATION OF SHB 2060 LOW INCOME HOUSING MONEY

WHEREAS, Senate House Bill 2060 was established to provide money for low income housing programs in Mason County for extremely low and very low income people, using the HUD guidelines;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes there is a tremendous need for low income housing programs in Mason County;

WHEREAS, the Mason County Housing Coalition and the City of Shelton reviewed the two proposals submitted and recommended approval to the Board of County Commissioners;

NOW THEREFORE, The Board of County Commissioners of Mason County does hereby approve the allocation of Senate House Bill 2060 low income housing money as follows: Turning Pointe (\$87,000) and Habitat for Humanity (\$72,376) subject to the execution of an agreement with Mason County pertaining to the use of funds.
