

RESOLUTION NO. 27-05
AFFIRMING ESTABLISHMENT OF VETERAN'S ASSISTANCE FUND
FUND NUMBER 190--000-000

WHEREAS, RCW 36.32.120, states “. the board of county commissioners...have the care of the county property and the management of the county funds and business.”


WHEREAS, RCW 73.08.080 requires Mason County to levy a property tax for the purpose of creating a veteran's assistance fund for the relief of honorably discharged veterans and the indigent wives, husbands, widows, widowers and minor children of such indigent or deceased veterans.

NOW THEREFORE, the Mason County Board of County Commissioners does hereby affirm the establishment of the Veteran's Assistance Fund (190-000-000) to receive revenues and pay the costs associated with the relief of honorably discharged veterans.


IT IS FURTHER ESTABLISHED THAT the Director of Operations will administer this fund and pay proper expenses from this fund as approved by the Mason County Board of County Commissioners.
