RESOLUTION NO. $_{51-05}$ A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE MASON COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS ACCESS PERMIT TIMEFRAME FROM 90 DAYS TO 180 DAYS

WHEREAS, the Access Permit, governed by RCW 36.75.130, which dictates the construction of the approach to a county road, is currently issued for a 90 day period. Mason County Public Works would like to adjust this timeframe to coincide with a Building Permit, which is a 180 day period.

WHEREAS, the Building Inspectors are checking to make sure the Access Permits are signed off and completed as part of their procedure in finalizing Building Permits, it is in the best interest of the County to have these permits on the same timeframe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Mason County Commissioners do hereby adopt that Access Permits will be issued for a period of 180 days.
