

Resolution No. 88-05

A resolution establishing the per diem amount for the Mason County Board of Equalization

WHEREAS, RCW 84.48.010 states "...the county legislative authority shall form a board for the equalization of the assessment of the property of the county. The members of said board shall receive a per diem amount as set by the county legislative authority for each day of actual attendance of the meeting of the board of equalization to be paid out of the current expense fund of the county...";

WHEREAS, county staff reviewed the per diem amounts of surrounding counties, including Thurston, Grays Harbor, Kitsap, Jefferson, Lewis and Clallam Counties and determined that \$100 is a fair and equitable per diem amount;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mason County Commissioners do hereby set the per diem rate at \$100 to be paid to the board of equalization members for attendance at each meeting of the board of equalization.




