## ORDINANCE NO. 99-05

## EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF ORDINANCE NO. 45-05 THAT IMPLEMENTS THE INTERIM ORDINANCE DELETING SEPA ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 45-05 was adopted by the Mason County Board of Commissioners on May 17, 2005. As an interim measure, this Ordinance enacted certain changes to the Title 8 Environmental Policy Ordinance and Title 15 Development Code that delete text which addresses SEPA administrative appeals. This Ordinance had an effective date to November 2, 2005; and

WHEREAS, to date the Mason County Comprehensive Plan and Development Regulations are still under review before the Planning Advisory Commission and the Mason County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, additional time is needed for public hearing to receive comment and testimony on final revisions made to Title 8 and Title 15, similar to those adopted by interim measure in Ordinance No. 45-05.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Mason County Board of Commissioners hereby extends the date of effective period of Ordinance No. 45-05 to May 2, 2006.

## **SECTION 2.**

Pursuant to RCW 36.70A.390, the Board will hold a public hearing on this extension of interim ordinance on December 20, 2005, at 9:30 A.M.
