**2006 BUDGET**

**Supplemental Appropriation/Budget Transfer Notice of Hearing**

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2006, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations and a budget transfer to the 2006 Budget as authorized by RCW 36.40.100 and RCW 36.40.195 for the following:

A transfer from the Current Expense Ending Fund Balance to the Fairgrounds for maintenance and repair costs and the purchase of new tents.

A supplemental appropriation for unanticipated revenue from the WA State Dept. of Community, Trade, and Economic Development (CTED) for a new .5 FTE employee in the Victims Witness Activities Fund.


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 17th of October 2006 at the hour of 9:30 AM in the Mason County Commissioners Chambers in Courthouse Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of a supplemental appropriation/budget transfer to the 2006 Budget as follows:


**Budget Transfer: Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$58,542**




