

RESOLUTION NO. 102-06  
2006 BUDGET  
Supplemental Appropriations

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2006, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the Budget as authorized by RCW 36.40.100 and RCW 36.40.195.

An operating transfer from the Capital Improvement REET 2 (Real Estate Excise Tax) Fund will be used for consultant costs in the Wastewater System Development Fund and the Storm Water System Development Fund.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 7<sup>th</sup> of November 2006 at the hour of 9:30 AM in the Mason County Commissioners Chambers in Courthouse Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of supplemental appropriations to the 2006 Budget as follows:

**Capital Improvement REET 2 Fund 351-000-000 (Operating Transfer Out) (\$184,750)**  
**Wastewater System Development Fund 405-000-000 (Operating Transfer In) \$134,750**  
**Storm Water System Development Fund 480-000-000 (Operating Transfer In) \$50,000**


