RESOLUTION NO. 103-06 TO TRANSFER RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT FROM THE SHERIFF TO PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, RCW 36.32.120 states ".. the board of county commissioners...have the care of the county property and the management of the county funds and business.."

WHEREAS, the Board of Mason County Commissioners wishes to re-establish responsibility for Emergency Management to a department under the authority of the Board;

NOW THEREFORE, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2007, the Board of Mason County Commissioners does hereby transfer responsibility for the Emergency Management Program from the Mason County Sheriff to Public Works; recognizing that the Mason County Search and Rescue Program will remain under the Sheriff's direction and administration.

FURTHERMORE, the Board of Mason County Commissioners acknowledges that the position of Emergency Management Manager was reinstated and budgeted during 2006; and that position will assist Public Works in the transfer and transition of the Emergency Management Program from the Mason County Sheriff to Public Works.

AND, IT IS FURTHER ESTABLISHED THAT, effective January 1, 2007, the Director of Public Works will administer Emergency Management and pay proper expenses of Emergency Management as approved by the Mason County Board of County Commissioners.
