

RESOLUTION NO. 116-06
AMENDING RESOLUTION 111-05 TO ESTABLISH SALARIES FOR PROSECUTING
ATTORNEY, SHERIFF, AND CORONER FOR 2007 AND FUTURE YEARS

WHEREAS, RCW 36.40.080 states that "... the Board of county Commissioners shall fix and determine each item of the budget separately and shall by resolution adopt the budget..."

WHEREAS, the fixing of Elected Officials salaries is an integral part of the budgeting process;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the compensation of the Prosecuting Attorney, Sheriff and Coroner should be adjusted;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby establish the following annual salary for Prosecuting Attorney, Sheriff and Coroner effective January 1, 2007:

PROSECUTING ATTORNEY	\$115,086
SHERIFF	\$80,727
CORONER	\$49,704


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, effective January 1, 2008 and each year thereafter, the salary for the Prosecuting Attorney, the Sheriff and the Coroner shall be increased 3%, rounded to the nearest whole dollar.
