WHEREAS, trails promote tourism and are a great community recreational asset, and

WHEREAS, a Master Trail Plan is needed to develop a systematic approach to developing a trail system in Mason County, and

WHEREAS, Mason County will receive a National Park Service Rivers, Trails, and Conservation Assistance Program Grant and a Trails Committee will be necessary to complete the Trails Plan, and

WHEREAS, citizen input is critical to formulating a Master Trail Plan, and

WHEREAS, the completion of the Trails Plan is a priority work item for the Parks and Trails Department in 2007;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioner that a Mason County Trails Committee shall be re-established and that the members and chairperson shall be appointed by the County Commissioners;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Committee shall be charged with the task of completing the Master Trails Plan for Mason County; the Committee shall terminate on December 31, 2007 unless extended by the County Commissioners; the Planning Advisory Commission and TIP-CAP shall be asked to appoint a liaison to the Committee; and the Planning Department and Parks and Trails Department shall provide staff assistance to the Committee.
