ORDINANCE NO. XX05x 36-06

EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF ORDINANCE NO. 99-05 THAT IMPLEMENTS THE INTERIM ORDINANCE DELETING SEPA ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 99-05 was adopted by the Mason County Board of Commissioners on October 25, 2005. As an interim measure, this Ordinance enacted certain changes to the Title 8 Environmental Policy Ordinance and Title 15 Development Code that delete text which addresses SEPA administrative appeals. This Ordinance had an effective date to May 2, 2006; and

WHEREAS, to date the Mason County Comprehensive Plan and Development Regulations have recently been under review for updating before the Planning Advisory Commission; and

WHEREAS, additional time is needed for public hearing to receive comment and testimony on final revisions made to Title 8 and Title 15, similar to those adopted by interim measure in Ordinance No. 45-05 and 99-05.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

SECTION 1.

The Mason County Board of Commissioners hereby extends the date of effective period of Ordinance No. 99-05 to from May 2, 2006 to July 11, 2006.

SECTION 2.

Pursuant to RCW 36.70A.390, the Board will hold a public hearing to receive comment and testimony on final revisions made to Title 8 and Title 15 on May 23, 2006 at 6:30 P.M.
