

MASON COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO: 51-06
COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO. 1877

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No 15500, known locally as Lynch Road, and more specifically located in Sec. 8 & 22, T19N, R3W, WM, at the approximate mile posts listed below; work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 4 on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

Repair road embankment that is damaged due to erosion and saturation of the fill slope caused by heavy rainfall. Area of repair is from approximate mp 0.74 to 0.80. Also replace spawning gravel washed for the culvert during winter storms.

SAID WORK is to be performed by day labor/contract in accordance with Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Engineering	\$ <u>5,000</u>
Right of Way	\$ <u>-0-</u>
Construction:	\$ <u>50,000</u>

The County Road project herein described in HEREBY DECLARED to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
