RESOLUTION NO. 63 -06

TO ESTABLISH RIGHT OF WAY WIDTH OF PANHANDLE LAKE ROAD (COUNTY ROAD NO. 04560)

WHEREAS Under RCW 36.68.010, Sixty feet is the necessary and proper width for county roads unless the Board of County Commissioners adopts a different width, and

WHEREAS Mason County's road standards provide for a minimum width of forty feet for local access roads, and

WHEREAS Panhandle Lake Road is a local access road that extends from Highland Road through timberland to the 4H Club Camp at Panhandle Lake, and

WHEREAS Public Works has no documentation on the establishment of this road nor on its right of way width, and

WHEREAS Panhandle Lake Road is a county road under RCW 36.75.070 by virtue of its maintenance by the County for over seven years and under RCW 36.75.080 by virtue of its use by the public for over ten years, and

WHEREAS Public Works wishes to establish a defined width for this road to facilitate maintenance and operation and has determined that forty feet is appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the right of way width of Panhandle Lake Road is established at forty feet and the County Engineer is authorized to seek and accept right of way easements from abutting property owners.
