COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO: 47-07
COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO. 1902

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 41780, known locally as the PURDY CUT-OFF ROAD, and more specifically located in Sec. 13, 14, 22, & 23, TN 21 N, RW 4 W, WM, at the approximate mile posts listed below; work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 1 on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

Repair the existing roadway surface by applying an asphalt concrete overlay to the existing road, including associated pavement marking and guardrail work from MP 0.00 to MP 2.77.

SAID WORK is to be performed by day labor/contract in accordance with Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Engineering	<u>\$20,000</u>
Right of Way	<u>\$0</u>
Construction:	<u>\$860,000</u>

The County Road project herein described in **HEREBY DECLARED** to be a public necessity, and the County Road Engineer is **HEREBY ORDERED AND AUTHORIZED** to report and proceed thereon as by law, provided and in accordance with WAC 136-18.
