

MASON COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO: 82-07  
COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO. 1903

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 41640, known locally as the Skokomish Valley Rd, and more specifically located in Sec.16, TN21N, R14W, WM, at the approximate mile posts listed below; work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 5 on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

Perform major repair work on existing bridge structure. Work to be performed at approximate mileposts: 0.66 to 0.72.

SAID WORK is to be performed by day labor/contract in accordance with Washington State Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Engineering      \$10,000

Right of Way      \$5,000

Construction:    \$85,000

80% of construction costs up to a maximum of \$156,000 is to be reimbursed by the Salmon Recovery Funding Board.


