

RESOLUTION NO. 83-09
2009 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year **2009**, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 for the following:

Revenues received in the Abatement Repair and Demolition Fund not anticipated in the adopted fund budget.

US Forest Service funds for the WSU Extension/Noxious Weed Program and Washington State Department of Ecology funds for the WSU Extension office for public education programs on water quality issues in the Totten and Eld Inlet area and public education programs on stormwater management.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 13th day of October 2009 at the hour of 9:30 a.m. in the Mason County Commissioners Chambers in Courthouse Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of a supplemental appropriation to the 2009 Budget as follows:


- Abatement Repair and Demolition Fund (118-000-000) in the estimated amount of \$81,500
- WSU Extension/Noxious Weed Program Fund in the estimated amount of \$17,500
- WSU Extension in the estimated amount of \$20,000


