

RESOLUTION NO. 95-09
2009 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION/BUDGET TRANSFER- NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year **2009**, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations and budget transfers to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 for the following:

Current Expense Fund: Clerk - \$2,000 transfer from ending fund balance for postage; Civil Service - \$1,200 net transfer from Sheriff's Office budget for testing requirements to fill a vacant position; Sheriff - \$114,614 net expenditure supplemental appropriation (\$115,814-\$1,200) for unanticipated grants.

Public Health Fund: \$42,000 supplemental appropriation for H1N1 Pandemic Response Plan.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Mason County Commissioners:


That the 24th day of November 2009 at the hour of 6:30 p.m. in the Mason County Commissioners Chambers in Courthouse Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of a supplemental appropriations and budget transfers to the 2009 Budget as follows:

- Current Expense Fund – Clerk \$2,000
- Current Expense Fund - Civil Service, \$1,200
- Current Expense Fund – Sheriff's Office - \$114,614
- Public Health Fund - \$42,000

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.




