## **RESOLUTION NO. 10-10**

A RESOLUTION relating to the repair and restoration of County Roads and Right-of-Ways following the installation of sewer mains and lateral connections in the Belfair Urban Growth Area when they are located within those County rights-of-ways.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has worked diligently for several years to improve the water quality in Hood Canal by constructing a sewer collection and disposal system in the Belfair area of Mason County and will in the future likely continue to construct and maintain additional sewer improvements within the Belfair Urban Growth Area and;

WHEREAS, Many of these sewer improvements will be located within the right-of-ways of Mason County Roads and;

WHEREAS, The installation of sewer improvements may damage these roadways as construction occurs and;

WHEREAS, The individual utilities should be responsible to do no harm to the County roadways and if damage occurs be responsible to fully repair all damage to the roadway equal to or better than conditions prior to any utility work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, the Belfair Wastewater Reclamation Utility (Utility), will be totally responsible for the cost necessary to repair and restore all damage to public right-of-ways as a result of utility installation work. In addition, the Utility will pledge monthly utility receipts to right-of-way damage repair work as their first priority until all repairs are approved to the satisfaction of the Public Works Director and all damage repair debts are satisfied.
